Greetings to you from the National Christian Council. .

We are pleased to meet with you, thank you for your gracious time to meet with us and hear our submission. We hereby present the following matters pertaining to the Christian Community and in the Education sector of Telangana state.

We thank your ministry and the Honourable Chief **Minister Shri K. Chandrasekhar Rao ji** for the services rendered to all sections of citizens in Telangana. Here we present few important matters for your perusal and kind attention.

### 1. Aided Schools:

The Christian Community was in the forefront of starting education to all sections especially to the weaker sections of the society rendering their services to give quality education and then the schools have become aided schools. The situation of the aided schools is very grim as posts are not being filled up when the teachers retire. Due to lack of teachers many students are dropping out of these schools and then the department is citing lack of strength to fill up the posts or to announce new posts for Aided Schools. We appeal to your good office to kindly take up this matter and see that where teachers retire and posts are vacant that they are filled without delay and that the existing schools be given full support to continue their mission of imparting education. As the main thrust of the missionary schools is imparting quality education to all, we urge that they be treated on par with the govt. Schools and aid and filling of the vacant posts and all the necessary support be kindly given to them so that they function fully well and serve the society.

### 2. Special Education to Differently Abled Children

We appreciate the TSSA that is doing great service to all the Special Needs Children in all the mandals of Telangana. We also request that Special Educators or Inclusive Education Resource Person (IERPs) be appointed for Aided Schools on a survey of Mandal or a Revenue Division basis that need such Person / Teacher.

### 3. Pandemic Affect:

During the Covid Pandemic many recognized schools have suffered as their income dropped. We request to consider to give a one time or few months honorarium to few senior teachers at least in the Private Schools that are recognized by the government and are based in the communities that are needy and to study if any assistance could be given to some schools / teachers as a one time or few months honorarium.

We believe education is of utmost important in the lives of people and pray to God that you will have wisdom and blessings in all your plans to see that all good plans and programs are implemented.

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4. Request to conduct **Special DSC for recruiting Special Educators as School Assistants in Telangana**, so that Special Educators could be fully accessible to the Special Needs Children throughout Telangana through the normal Schools that are in local areas. Some IERPs are working in TSSA for many long years. All the IERPs that are working in TSSA should be given the same pay scale as SGTs. This special DSC is conducted by several states including Andhra Pradesh state. And recently Andhra Pradesh has also given Minimum of Time Scale (MST) for contract employees in the Revised Pay Scales of 2022.

The care that can be extended and accessibility given to the overlooked or neglected community of **Differently Abled Divyang Children** will truly make our state a **Bangaaru Telangana** to them and it will be an exemplary gesture of a state truly caring for our own needy children.

## 5. Bicycles for Girl Children in all Telangana

As the Covid pandemic disturbed the school going process so much, we would like to request that all school going girl children in Telangana state be given a bicycle as a gift from the government. The uses of a bicycle are so many that it gives mobility and empower the girl to go to school and do her works for the family without being dependent on anyone else, physical exercise, maintains physical distance in this troubled pandemic times, keeps the girls fit and agile. It's preserving environment by non-pollution without any gas emission and not having any difficulties on the family budget for Petrol / Oil purchases.
